Varanasi, (also known as Kashi) is the abode of Lord Shiva and one of the oldest living city in the world. City is situated on the banks of the Ganges where 84 Ghats of river Ganges form the symbolic semi-lunar chain of the city. Varanasi lies along with National Highway 2 (Kolkata to Delhi), and is well connected by Railways and Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport.

The major attraction of the places are Subah –*e*-banares (sun rising events), Ganga Arti, and ancient spiritual sites of temples of Hinduism, Jainism, and Buddhism. Kashi Vishwanath Temple of Lord Shiva, Sankat Mochan Hanuman Temple, Durga Temple, Tulasi Manas Temple, Bharat Mata Temple and Kal Bhirav are the most revered Hindus pilgrimage places. Sarnath, situated 10 Km northeast from Varanasi is one of the most revered pilgrimage centre of Buddhism where Lord Buddha preached his first sermon in 500 BC. Varanasi is also renowned for Indian classical & folk music, Banarasi Silk Saries, Arts & crafts.

Banaras Hindu University (BHU) established in 1916 by **Bharat Ratna Mahamana Pt. Madan Mohan Malaviya Ji** and one of the most prestigious Central Universities of the country. Largest residential University of the Asia with the humble message *Sarvavidhya ki Rajdhani* is the only University of India.

Ayurveda is the science of life practiced by ancient Aryans is based on Atharva Veda, one of the oldest scripture of Hindus. Mahamana Pt. Call for papers, Abstract Format Details

Abstract and full papers are invited for poster/oral presentation from individuals, groups and organizations. The abstract should be typed in Times New Roman of 12 points in 1.5 lines spacing carrying title in capital bold, followed by the author name(s), affiliation, postal address and email Id of the corresponding author. Two copies of abstract not exceeding 150 words (without any sketch & table) along with two copies of summary not exceeding 400 words (including objective(s) of the study, the methods used, results obtained and conclusions drawn) should be submitted in soft copy and hard copy on A4 size paper with 2.5 cm margin from all sides.

Last date of submission of paper is 05th December 2017. Paper can also be submitted by email to icfaeam2018@gmail.com.

The abstract and full papers will be accepted for oral / poster presentation after due scrutiny by scientific committee. Some selected full paper of conference proceedings will be published as a special issue in International Journal of Green Pharmacy (UGC Approved Journal) as per norm of journal with additional fee of Rs. 500/- only.
